

FRAMEWORK FOR SPEAKER PRESENTATIONS AND POSTER DISPLAY APPLICATIONS

The information submitted in this first one-page application, will represent the support for selection of speakers and poster displays.

Your abstract submission must include all of the following:

1. PAPER TITLE

2. AUTHORS (principal author first). Must include authors' names, affiliations and email address of the corresponding author.

3. PRESENTATION PREFERENCE "Oral Presentation" or "Poster Presentation."

4. PRESENTING AUTHORS' BIOGRAPHY Approximately 50 - 100 words.

5. ABSTRACT TEXT Approximately 200 words. Accepted abstracts will be included in the conference handbook and post-event proceedings. Please submit only 200-word abstracts that are suitable for publication and include supporting data (graphs, diagrams, drawings, photos) of the presented research.

Please remember to spell check your entire paper.

Conditions of Acceptance

- ⚠ **Authors are expected to secure funding for travel, and accommodation, before submitting abstracts.** This will not be covered by the IoN.
- ⚠ Only original material should be submitted.
- ⚠ Commercial papers and papers with no new research/development content will not be accepted.
- ⚠ Abstracts should contain enough detail to clearly convey the approach and the results of the research.

By submitting your abstract you agree that all permissions have been approved, and authorize the IoN to circulate your abstract to conference committee members for review and selection purposes and if it is accepted, to publish your abstract in conference documentation and post-event proceedings. Authors are required to attend at the conference to present their work. Papers will not be published where no author attends at the meeting.

Please also confirm whether you are able to provide a demonstration of your work during your talk (if selected).

On acceptance of short abstracts, authors will be notified of acceptance presentation mode (poster/oral).
