

CALL FOR POSTERS:
FRAMEWORK FOR POSTER DISPLAY APPLICATIONS

Nanoparticles for European Industry II

All abstracts will be reviewed by the scientific advisory board and authors notified of the status of their submission within 4 weeks of submission.

This two day conference will bring together industry leaders, regulators and legislators, and the cream of academic research in nanoparticle R&D.

The conference consists of the following oral sessions:

1. Measurement, Characterisation and Standardisation;
2. Manufacturing Scale-up and Processing;
3. Regulations, Risks and Toxicology

Abstracts are now invited for the accompanying poster session (**submission no later than 1/10/07**).

Your abstract submission must include all of the following:

1. PAPER TITLE

2. AUTHORS (principal author first). Must include authors' names, affiliations and email address of the corresponding author.

3. PRESENTATION PREFERENCE Please state your preference for an oral or poster presentation.
POSTER PRESENTATION NOW ONLY AVAILABLE.

4. PRESENTING AUTHORS' BIOGRAPHY Approximately 50 - 100 words.

5. ABSTRACT TEXT Maximum 400 words. Accepted abstracts will be included in the conference handbook and post-event proceedings. Please submit only 400-word abstracts that are suitable for publication and include supporting data (graphs, diagrams, drawings, photos) of the presented research. (Times New Roman 12 pt used throughout, with title in bold) **Please remember to spell check your entire paper.**

Conditions of Acceptance

- ❖ **Authors are expected to secure funding for travel, and accommodation, before submitting abstracts.** This will not be covered by the IoN.
- ❖ Only original material should be submitted.
- ❖ Commercial papers and papers with no new research/development content will not be accepted – exhibition opportunities available.
- ❖ Abstracts should contain enough detail to clearly convey the approach and the results of the research.

By submitting your abstract you agree that all permissions have been approved, and authorize the IoN to circulate your abstract to conference committee members for review and selection purposes and if it is accepted, to publish your abstract in conference documentation and post-event proceedings. Authors are required to attend at the conference to present their work. Papers will not be published where no author attends at the meeting.
