Reflecting the growing activity in this emerging specialty, the aim of this journal is to highlight research and development leading to potential clinical applications in the prevention and treatment of disease.



Topics of interest include:

- Application of nanotechnology in the diagnosis, prevention, and treatment of disease
- Diagnostic tools, analytical techniques, including biochips, microarrays, biosensors, molecular sensors, nanoprobes, nanoscale genomic and proteomic research, and nanoimaging
- Nanodevices and nanomaterials, including nanotubes, fullerenes, biomedical microsystems, device miniaturization, cellular and tissue engineering, and nano bioresponsive systems (diagnostic and drug delivery devices)
- Nanodrug complexes and drug delivery systems including polymer therapeutics (eg, pegylated proteins, polymer drug conjugates, polymeric drugs) for improved drug, protein, or gene transport and targeting
- Specific focus on development and clinical use from the perspectives of safety, efficacy, economics, and ultimate patient uptake.
