Conference Overview

The Institute on Nanotechnology (IoN) will be holding a two day event on 'Nanotechnologies and Smart Textiles for Industry and Fashion' on the 11- 12th October 2006.

Nanotechnology is opening the door to a whole spectrum of new markets for the textile and related industries. Applications range from fashion to health to leisure to defence, and are found in industries as diverse as aerospace, automotive and construction.

Nanotechnology is being used to add imaginative and exciting properties to textiles for fashion and industry. These range from scent-embedded textiles, stay-clean textiles, textiles with displays, textiles that can change colour, or even lightweight textiles that are so strong they can withstand the impact of a bullet. Many new textiles are also being developed that not only promote faster healing of patients recovering from surgical procedures to fabrics but also enhance health and well being in the ageing population.

Some nano-enabled new textiles are able to communicate with each other, and even transmit information on physical stresses and strains. Others can use the latest technology to exude insect repellants or pharmacological therapies on demand.

One of the interesting themes of this conference will be to explore the 'fashion paradox' - how nanotechnology can support fashion while addressing concerns for sustainability and the reduction of energy use and waste.

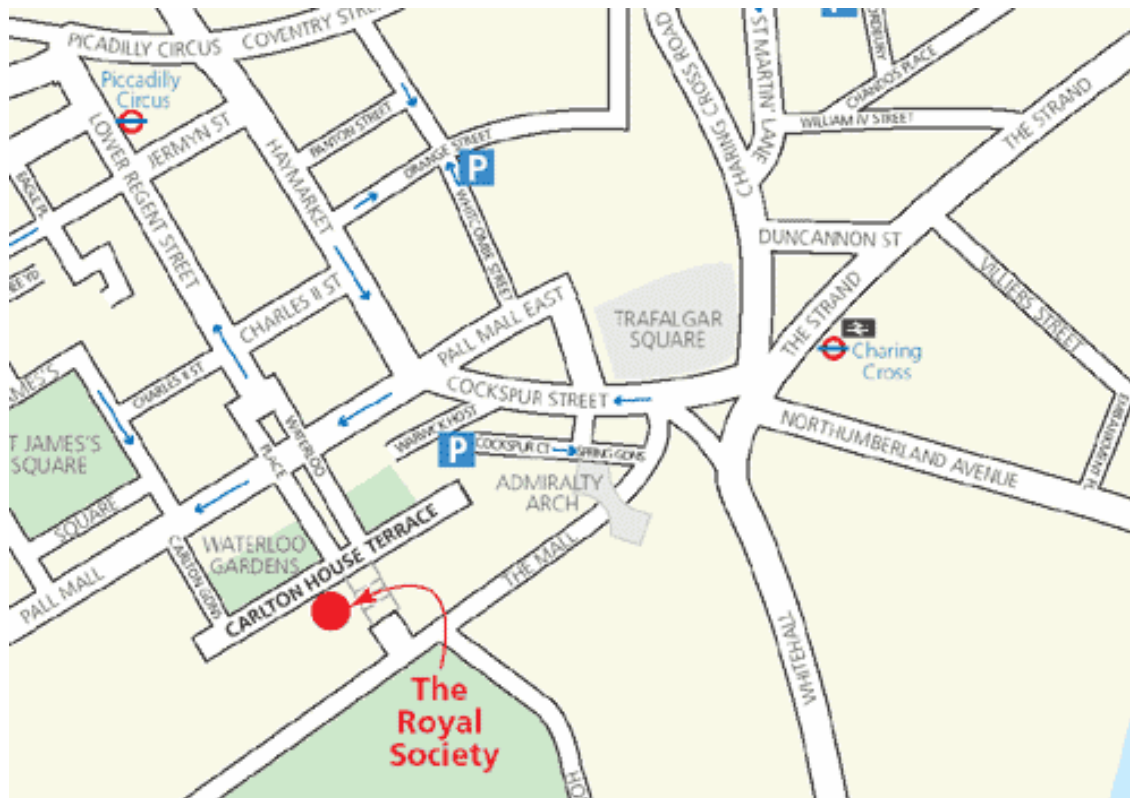
B1.2 Car Parking
